Amberley Gibbs Jochens – Birth Injury Program

Recent legislation for the Birth Injury Program was passed to allow neurologically impaired infants who were born between January 1, 1998 and July 1, 1993 and filed claims that were denied to re-file a petition by July 1, 2007. Ms. Jochens filed one of the four claims under this House Bill for a neurologically impaired infant who had been denied acceptance into the Birth Injury Program. The Commission should rule by early next year.
